Treasurer's Update:

- Entering this school year with significantly less funds than usual due to Covid impact on fundraising initiatives
- Expecting \$5,000 \$7,000 Gaming Grant
- Have approximately \$20,000 this year (including Gaming Grant)
- Typically provide school with \$16,000 every school year
- Propose to reduce amount to \$10,000 to ensure similar amount available next school year as fundraising initiatives heavily impacted
